

Management Actions:

An Appeals Board was convened at River Bend Station to review a "Positive" pre-access test. The Board concluded that the testing process and the decision of the Medical Review Officer were properly executed. The determination of "Positive" was upheld by the Board.

Fitness For Duty Initiatives Taken:

- FFD Coordinators at the four Entergy sites met with computer personnel periodically to discuss improvements in the HEIDI (Health Education and Information System for Drug Abuse in Industry) Data Base. Initiatives are underway to either upgrade the HEIDI or to replace it with a program developed exclusively by Entergy Operations.
- The FFD Department performed random drug testing at a rate of 60% for 1995. This exceeds the required testing rate at River Bend Station by an additional 10%.
- The FFD Department has expanded its facility and is in the planning stage of upgrading the facility to enhance processing of personnel during plant outages.

Effectiveness Evaluation:

The Fitness-For-Duty Department will continue to update and revise FFD procedures based on operating experience, lessons learned, and NRC inspections conducted at other nuclear sites.
