Our letter dated June 3, 1992 concerning the subject matter described an internal policy statement issued by New Jersey State Police. The internal policy statement requires, effective immediately, their duty officer or hazardous material emergency response personnel to promptly notify the OCNGS Group Shift Supervisor (GSS) or OCNGS Control Room upon a transportation related, hazardous material air release incident occurring in Lacey or Ocean Townships that could have an impact on the operation of OCNGS.

In our recent telephone conversation, Mr. A. Dromerick, Senior Project Manager - NRR, requested the attached copy of the internal policy statement.



Williams Supervisor  OK	Re: OCGNS HazMat Notification Procedure The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has asked Oyster Creek Generating Station to plan for a possible transportation related air release of a hazardous material which could effect control room personnel. Plant authorities have asked that our office notify the group shift supervisor, at (609) 971-4667 or the Oyster Creek control room, at (609) 971-4666 under the following circumstance: A transportation related, hazardous material air release occurring in <u>Lacey</u> or <u>Ocean</u> Townships that could have an impact on the plant.

The NRC is concerned about the remote potential of an airborne contaminant entering the air intakes and effecting control room personnel at the facility.

Upon notification from the DEPE Hotline of the circumstance stated above the enliste duty officer (during off hours) or HMERF Personnel (during work hours) will notify the OCGNS control room.


This policy is effective immediately.
