This letter provides the information requested by Administrative Letter 96-01, which was received at the Fermi Plant on January 12, 1996.

Part A of the attached NRC Form 536 has been completed, indicating the estimated number of candidates to be examined during each of the two annual scheduled site visits. For fiscal years 1998 and 1999, the desired primary date is indicated as December 1997 and 1998 respectively (the normal scheduled date for all candidates), should scheduling allow for only one NRC examination visit per fiscal year. Section B of the form has been completed as requested.

The next scheduled licensed operator requalification examinations (which is provided for NRC resource planning for requalification program inspections) is scheduled for the period from November 4, 1996 through December 13, 1996.

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
