SEMI-ANNUAL FITNESS FOR DUTY PROGRAM PERFORMANCE REPORT

Attached is Consumers Power Company's Semi-Annual Fitness for Duty Program Performance Report for the period July 1, 1995, through December 31, 1995. This report is submitted according to the requirements of 10CFR26.71(d).

Consumers Power Company conducted 321 random tests during this period. The tests resulted in one positive THC result on a contractor/vendor. Follow-up, for cause, post-accident, and pre-access testing did not result in any positive drug/alcohol determinations.

An occurrence involving Medical Review Officer (MRO) communications with an individual having a presumptive THC result led to modifications made to the MRO guidelines.

A program was completed for improving the Fitness for Duty procedures by providing guidance which will assure NRC reportability is handled appropriately and within the required time frame. Job aids were developed for actions upon (1) Firearm Discovery, (2) Unknown Substance Discovery, and (3) Discovery of Alcohol in the Protected Area.

1. MANAGEMENT SUMMARY

During this reporting period, Consumers Power Company conducted a total of 321 random tests with the following results:

The year-end positive drug/alcohol rate, as compared to previous year-end results, indicates a downward trend for employees and contractors:

Additional testing included 166 pre-access, 3 post-accident, 3 for-cause and 22 follow-up tests. All processes did not identify any positive drug/alcohol results.

The appeal process was not initiated during this reporting period.

2. INITIATIVES TAKEN

The January 1-June 30, 1995 semi-annual report documented an occurrence where an unknown substance was found in the Radiologically Controlled Area of the Palisades Plant. This incident initiated procedural improvements to assure future occurrences would be handled by the appropriate staff and to assure proper notification(s) are made in a timely manner. Ultimately three job aids were created to direct actions upon (1) Firearm Discovery, (2) Unknown Substance Discovery, and (3) The Discovery of Alcohol in the Protected Area.

3. REPORTABLE EVENTS UNDER 10CFR26, SECTION 26.73

During this six month interval, Consumers Power Company did not encounter any FFD event that required reporting under 10CFR26, Part 26.73.

4. LESSONS LEARNED

Processes involving the MRO contact of an individual having a presumptive positive test result and final notification to management, have been altered following an incident which occurred at the Palisades Plant.

MRO requirements in 10CFR25, Appendix A state the MRO shall discuss a potential positive test result with an individual prior to management notification. Upon receipt of a positive THC determination on a contract employee, the MRO 's three attempts to contact the individual at his residence failed. Ultimately, the MRO was able to reach the individual who was in the plant containment area and discussed the THC result. Further miscommunications inadvertently prevented Consumers Power Company management from immediate knowledge of the positive determination, however actions did take place by the individual's on-site supervisor to revoke his access.

MRO Guidelines were revised directing contact with individuals made either off-site or through the HR Department only. Listing of Consumers Power Company Fitness For Duty Administrators were provided to the MROs with work, home and pager numbers. Additional instructions for notification were provided to the MRO assistants to prevent a recurrence of this situation.
