## MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Commission's Final Rule on Financial Qualifications)

In our Memorandum and Order (Stating Significant Developments Since Memorandum and Order dated November 10, 1982) dated April 26, 1984 we indicated that the Commission was, at that time, considering the effect of New England Coalition on Nuclear Pollution v. NRC, No. 82-1581 (D.C. Cir., Feb. 7, 1984) on pending OL proceedings, and we stated that we would advise the parties to this proceeding of the Commission's decision when it was issued. The Commission's final rule was issued September 12, 1984 (Elimination of Review of Financial Qualifications of Electric Utilities in Operating License Review and Hearings for Nuclear Power Plants, 49 Fed. 35747 (1984)). In that decision, the Commission amended 10 C.F.R. Parts 2 and 50 to eliminate financial qualification review and findings in OL proceedings, but it reinstated a requirement

for financial qualification review and findings for electric utilities applying for construction permits.

## ORDER

In consideration of the foregoing it is hereby ORDERED

That this Board's order dismissing Contention 3 in Memorandum and Order, LBP-82-103, 16 NRC 1603 (1982), at 1607, is affirmed.
