ORDER

The Commission has decided to allow oral presentations on September 21, 1984, at 10:00 a.m., by the parties to this proceeding who submitted written comments to the Commission on September 14, 1984 concerning the Low-Power Licensing Board's Order of September 5, 1984. Each party will have fifteen minutes to address the Commission¹ as to whether the September 5, 1984 decision of the Licensing Board conducting this proceeding provides an adequate basis on which to authorize the issuance of an operating license allowing Phase I and Phase II of low-power testing. The parties should focus especially on the applicability of the pending physical security contentions in this regard.
