SUBJECT: CHANGES TO THE FORT CALHOUN STATION EMERGENCY PLAN, REVISION 20.

EMERGENCY PLAN FORMS, REVISION 3: AND PLANT PROCEDURE OERP01-ZV-

1NO1, EMERGENCY CLASSIFICATION, REVISION 2

We have received your submissions of Revision 3 to the Fort Calhoun Station Emergency Plan Forms, dated August 21, 1995; Revision 20 to the site Radiological Emergency Response Plan, dated October 10, 1995; and Plant Procedure OPAP01-ZA-0102, "Emergency Classification," dated August 21, 1995. These revisions were submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 50,54(q) and 10 CFR 50.4; and incorporated the following changes:

- (1) Emergency Plan Forms Revision 3: Positions were eliminated on Form FC-EPF-10. Instrument changes and a different font were used on FC-EPF-2. On FC-EPF-8, the GM pancake probe replaced the HP-260 probe.
- (2) Emergency Plan Revision 20: RERP-Section B and RERP-Section F removed certain positions and reassigned responsibilities to other existing positions. RERP-Section E Added description for new callout process. Changed off-site notification process to include counties for all classification. RERP-Section H Revised facility diagrams to reflect position changes and Emergency Operations Facility remodeling.
- (3) Plant Procedure OERP01-ZV-1N01 Revision 2: Changed Initiating Condition SG1 to reflect new coping period analysis to ensure compliance with 10 CFR 50.63, as interpreted by NUMARC Guideline 87-00, Revision 0 and Regulatory Guide 1.155. Change also reflected in bases for emergency action level.

Our review determined that the changes are acceptable and do not appear to degrade the effectiveness of your emergency planning at the Fort Calhoun Station.
