Gentlemen:

This correspondence is to update the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on the Nebraska Public Power District's (District's) commitment to fully implement the enhancement to the existing training tracking system at Cooper Nuclear Station (CNS) as stated in previous District correspondence (references 1 and 2).

This commitment is one of the corrective steps in response to violations which occurred due to inadequate overview and commitment to the STA Training Program implementation by management and the involved individuals and an inadequate overview of the fire brigade training program. The intent of this commitment was to develop and install a new software system to provide an upgraded computerized tool to support District management and supervision while implementing the requirements of the training program.

The Corporate Training System (CTS) replaced the previous Training Tracking System on December 15, 1995. While CTS is still being refined, it fulfills the attributes committed to in the referenced correspondence. With its implementation, the District has completed this committed action.
