SUBJECT: REED REACTOR FACILITY EMERGENCY PLAN (TAC. NO. M83301)

We have reviewed the proposed emergency plan changes for the Reed Reactor Facility forwarded by your letter of May 7, 1992, as supplemented by letters of May 15, and June 3, 1992. The proposed changes remove unnecessary conservatism from their Emergency Action Levels and brings the Emergency Plan Into a form consistent with standard regulatory guidance.

The emergency plan changes were reviewed against the requirements of Appendix E to 10 CFR 50, the guidance criteria set forth in Regulatory Guide 2.6 and NUREG-0849, "Standard Review Plan for the Review and Evaluation of Emergency Plans for Research and Test Reactors." This review was performed under 10 CFR 50.54(q), which states that proposed changes that decrease the effectiveness of the approved emergency plans may not be implemented without application to and approval by the Commission. Enclosed is our Safety Evaluation (SE) in which we conclude that the proposed changes are acceptable and in accord with NRC guidance. This acceptance includes the NRC's understanding and the Reed College Reactor Facility's commitment that the implementing procedures for the emergency plan changes are in place and applicable staff trained in these procedures.
