

Dear Mr. Reynolds:

This is in response to your letter of January 24, 1996 in which you requested, on behalf of the Director of Nuclear Safety at River Bend Station in Louisiana and the immediate supervisor of an employee who was potentially subject to discrimination, transcripts of interviews conducted by the Office of Investigations (OI) with these individuals for the individuals' use in preparation for the predecisional enforcement conference which they have been asked to attend. The OI report includes transcripts of two interviews conducted with the Director of Nuclear Safety and one with the immediate supervisor. These documents have been reviewed for personal privacy information and appropriate portions have been redacted. 
