A. Description and Cause of Noncompliance: One iron sample out of four on May 5-6, 1992, was out of compliance. Two analyses were performed on the 5:30 a.m. sample (5/6). Data revealed 0.98 mg/l iron but a duplinate analysis did not fall within our acceptable standard deviation. The analysis was therefore thrown out.
