SUBJECT: CHANGES TO THE CALLAWAY PLANT RADIOLOGICAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

We have reviewed your letter dated July 5, 1995, and Change Notices dated September 18 (two) and October 13, 1995, and the enclosed changes to the Callaway Plant Radiological Emergency Response Plan, Revision 19 and Change Notices 95-02, 95-03, and 95-04, respectively. The revisions were submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(q). Revision 19 incorporated the following changes: (1) the threshold for emergency operations facility activation was changed from the site emergency (utility term) to the alert classification level. (2) reference to the operations support center/area was deleted due to the facility's collocation with the technical support center, (3) the emergency response organization was changed to support the combined operations support/technical support center and the merging of the public information and emergency operations facility emergency organizations. (4) the locations of the joint public information center and backup emergency operations facility were changed, (5) the letters of agreement review dates were updated, and (6) editorial changes were made to eliminate unnecessary detail and internal references, and to keep the plan current. Change Notice 95-02 modified the reference/information concerning emergency worker exposure limits. Change Notice 95-03 incorporated editorial changes for consistency with Revision 19. Change Notice 95-04 deleted reference to the construction siren.

Based on our review, we determined that the changes are acceptable and do not appear to degrade the effectiveness of your emergency planning at Callaway Plant. The results of our review were discussed with Mr. John Neudecker on January 9, 1996. Mr. Neudecker agreed to add the following information to the next revision to the emergency plan: (1) identify the non-delegable responsibilities of the recovery manager, (2) expand the description of the technical support center functions, and (3) identify the Notification and Coordination Line telephone locations. Mr. Neudecker also agreed to consider whether emergency response facility floor plans could be reinstated with a reduced level of detail without creating an updating burden.
