SUBJECT: OYSTER CREEK SER REGARDING TRANSPORTATION HAZARDS

Enclosed is our SER input regarding the resolution of the transportation hazard issue associated with truck traffic on U.S. Route 9 in the vicinity of Oyster Creek. The evaluation addresses the licensee's response to the staff request for an assessment of the hazards and any appropriate measures that may be needed to assure that the risks are acceptably low.

On the basis of discussions with the licensee on May 11, 1992, and the information provided by the licensee in subsequent correspondence (letters from GPJ Nuclear Corp. to the staff, dated June 3 and 11, 1992) we find that the steps taken by the licensee provide adequate assurance that the subject hazards do not pose an undue risk to the safe operation of the plant.
