Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted under the Resident Inspector Program by Messrs. G. L. Constable, T. A. Flippo, and Ms. K. A. Whittlesey of this office during the period May 1, 1984, through June 30, 1984, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit CPPR-103 for the Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3, and to the discussion of our findings with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included human engineering walkdown; operational readiness meeting; test results evaluation; emergency operating procedures training; startup test procedure review; surveillance and maintenance procedure reviews; review of IE Bulletins, Circulars, and Generic Letters; system open items review; open issues review; Three Mile Island open items; followup on previous NRC inspection findings; followup on 50.55(e) items; and safety review committee activity. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. These findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Based on your corrective action and planned followup, you are not required to formally respond to this item of noncompliance. The details are contained in the Notice of Violation and the inspection report enclosed with this letter.

We have also examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified inspection findings. The status of these items is identified in paragraph 13 of the enclosed report.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within 10 days of the date of this letter, and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within 30 days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).
