This letter is to inform you of a change made in the scheduling of the Seismic Qualification Review Team and Pump and Valve Operability Audits to be conducted by your organization. As the criteria for conducting these audits are that 85% - 90% of the safety-related equipment be installed and qualified, we have now projected this date to be August of 1985 for BV-2. This date is in line with your suggestion that the audits occur 9-12 months before fuel load which is now projected for June 1986.
