POSITIVE TEST RESULTS

No employee or contractor employees tested positive during this report period.

FITNESS FOR DUTY PROGRAM CHANGES

No significant Fitness For Duty Program changes occurred.

EVENTS REPORTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 10CFR26.73

On September 19, 1995 while conducting maintenance on the condenser a used marijuana pipe was discovered. The pipe was made out of stainless steel pipe fittings and was hidden in the web of an "I" beam. It was found in the vicinity of the upper level water boxes on the east side of the condenser at approximately the 2050' level.

Due to the location and lack of odor on the pipe, it was probably last used during the construction era. Remnants of marijuana were found in the pipe. A phone call was made to the NRC Operations Center per 10 CFR 26.73(a)(1) which requires the possession of illegal drugs within the protected area to be reported within 24 hours. This event is being included in the semi-annual report pursuant to 10 CFR 26.71(d).
