COMPLAINT

On January 4, 1988, the U. S. Department of Labor (DOL) issued their ruling on complaint of discrimination filed against Bechtel on September 4, 1987. The DOL concluded that the allegations made by were unprovable in that his concerns did not relate to nuclear safety and his termination was a result of an ongoing Bechtel reduction of force at South Texas Project.

Was advised that he had the right of appeal, but that unless he appealed within the specified time this would close out the DOL action on his complaint.

The DOL finding in case parallels the OI conclusion that terminated in a reduction of force and received all due retirement benefits. It was further concluded in the OI report that was not terminated because of his attempt to report safety concerns.
