License Amendment Application to Revise the Facility Operating License
to Reflect the Proposed Merger of Operating Companies - Supplemental
Information

Gentlemen:

An application was submitted on June 2, 1994 (letter PY-CEI/NRR-1794L), for an amendment to the PNPP Operating License, Number NPF-58. The proposed changes reflected the pending merger of the Toledo Edison Company into the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company. A supplemental letter was submitted on July 29, 1994 (letter PY-CEI/NRR-1832L), to further clarify the original application and to discuss the effect of the proposed merger on the Beaver Valley Power Station Unit 2 Operating License.

The original application indicated that the proposed merger necessitating the operating license transfer was planned to be completed by the end of 1994, so that the merged company could become a viable corporate entity by January 1, 1995. Accordingly, conditional NRC approval of the license transfer application was requested by November 30, 1994. CEI further supplemented the application by letter dated November 10, 1994 (PY-CEI/NRR-1883L), requesting that further activity regarding the application be deferred until May 1, 1995, due to delays of approvals from other regulatory agencies.

Extended delays in obtaining such approvals make it necessary to request that NRC activity regarding the application be again deferred until December 1, 1995. The NRC Project Manager for PNPP will be informed of any further developments.


