Enclosed please find a manual containing a description of the Fort Calhoun Station's (FCS) 1995 Emergency Preparedness Exercise to be conducted on Tuesday, November 14, 1995. The Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) is transmitting this submittal sixty days prior to the exercise in accordance with established standards.

As indicated in Reference 2, Objective 17 of the FCS 1995 Emergency Preparedness Exercise scenario has been modified to address questions asked by Ms. Gail Good (NRC) during a discussion with Mr. Ronald Meng (OPPD) on August 25, 1995.

Copies of the offsite portions of this submittal are being sent to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Region VII, for their information. The States of Iowa and Nebraska will be participating in the exercise in accordance with the finalized Extent of Play memorandums submitted to FEMA.

The NRC's emergency exercise inspection team will be briefed by OPPD personnel on any revisions made to this manual after the date of transmittal.


