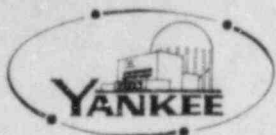

Dear Sir:

In accordance with Article IWA-6000 of Section XI of the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code, we hereby submit the Inservice Inspection Report of the Yankee Nuclear Power Station for the period of March 31, 1984 through June 9, 1984.

Included in this report is the form NIS-1 as required by the provisions of ASME Section XI.

Also enclosed are copies of Sections 7 and 8 of WCAP-10561 which contain information which is proprietary to Westinghouse. Accordingly, we request that this information be withheld from public disclosure.

In order not to delay this submittal of information requested by the Commission, we will comply with the requirements of 10CFR2.790 to provide proprietary and non-proprietary versions together with an affidavit as soon as the proprietary information contained in the submittal has been specifically identified and the proprietary and non-proprietary versions have been prepared. We will submit the total required number of copies of the proprietary and non-proprietary versions of the information and the required affidavit at that time.

In the meantime, we have provided sufficient copies for you to initiate your review. E. Shomaker, Esquire, of the NRC Office of the Executive Legal Director, has advised Westinghouse that he concurs with this procedure.


