All correspondence and other written communications between you and General Public Utilites, Metropolitan Edison Company, GPU Service Corporation, GPU Nuclear Corporation or Group, Pennsylvania Electric Company, or Jersey Central Power and Light Corp., or employees thereof regarding reporting of information during the March 28, 1979 accident to the NRC or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
