SUBJECT: REPORT NOS. 50-280/84-18 AND 50-281/84-19

On May 29 - June 1, 1984, NRC inspected activities authorized by NRC Operating License Nos. DPR-32 and DPR-37 for your Surry facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

The inspection findings indicate that certain activities violated NRC requirements. The violations, references to pertinent requirements, and elements to be included in your response are presented in the enclosed Notice of Violation.

Based on a telephone conversation held on June 22, 1984, between J. L. Wilson, Station Manager, and H. C. Dance of the Region II office, it is our understanding that a review of station radioactive material shipment procedures will be made to provide additional assurance that shipments are properly braced prior to
