Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2
Proposed Revision to Technical Specifications
Service Water Pump Flood Protection

By letter dated December 16, 1994, (1) Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) submitted an amendment request to the NRC Staff which would revise the Technical Specifications (TS) of Millstone Unit No. 2. The proposed changes would modify the Limiting Conditions for Operation (LCO) for TS 3.7.5.1.b, "Plant Systems-Flood Level," and correct a value listed in TS Table 3.3-8, "Meteorological Monitoring Instrumentation." The proposed LCO changes had no significant operational impact, but were intended to provide increased uniformity for station severe weather meteorological monitoring. The table change was to correct a typographical error in the table listing.

The purpose of this letter is to withdraw the proposed changes discussed above. This withdrawal was agreed to in a telephone call with the Staff on August 21, 1995, and is in response to a letter from the NRC on the same subject dated August 3, 1995. (2) The
