Dear Mr. Powell:

This firm is currently engaged in litigation in which an individual, Arnold Gundersen ("Gundersen"), has raised certain purported violations of health and safety laws. Please provide us with copies of the following documents:

- 1. All documents concerning an inspection or investigation performed by an NRC investigator at Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. (n/k/a NES, Inc.), 44 Shelter Rock Road, Danbury, Connecticut 06810, on or about July 1990, at the instigation of Complainant Gundersen, including, but not limited to, complaints, letters, investigation notes, field notes, logs, affidavits, reports, conclusions, findings, and any record of actions taken pursuant to the inspection or investigation.
- 2. The report issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") on October 24, 1990, concluding that Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. had not violated any Commission regulations with respect to Gundersen.
- 3. All documents concerning an inspection or investigation performed by a Department of Labor Wage & Hour Administration investigator at Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. (n/k/a NES. Inc.), 44 Shelter Rock Road, Danbury, Connecticut 06810, on or about July 1990, at the instigation of Complainant Gundersen, including, but not limited to, complaints, letters, investigation notes, field notes, logs, affidavits, reports, conclusions, findings, and any record of actions taken pursuant to the inspection or investigation.
- 4. The report issued by the Department of Labor Wage & Hour Administration on July 12, 1990, ruling that discrimina-

tion was not a factor in Gundersen's termination from Nuclear Energy Services. Inc., and advising Gundersen of his right to appeal within five days to the Department of Labor Chief Administrative Law Judge.

- The settlement agreement entered into between Gundersen and Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. on December 20, 1990.
- 6. The February 12, 1991 letter sent by Gundersen to the NRC claiming that the settlement agreement with Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. contained paragraphs that were illegal and therefore null and void.
- 7. All documents concerning an inspection or investigation performed by an NRC investigator at Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. (n/k/a NES, Inc.), 44 Shelter Rock Road, Danbury, Connecticut 06810, on or about June 1992, at the instigation of Complainant Gundersen, including, but not limited to, complaints, letters, investigation notes, field notes, logs, affidavits, reports, conclusions, findings and any records of actions taken pursuant to the inspection or investigation.
- 8. The Notice of Violation issued by the NRC on July 12, 1992 to Nuclear Energy Services, Inc., citing seven violations related to Nuclear Energy Service, Inc.'s radiation safety program.
- 9. All documents concerning an inspection or investigation performed by a Department of Labor Wage & Hour Administration investigator at Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. (n/k/a NES, Inc.), 44 Shelter Rock Road, Danbury, Connecticut 06810, on or about June 1992, at the instigation of Complainant Gundersen, including, but not_limited to, complaints, investigation notes, field notes, logs, affidavits, reports, conclusions, findings, and any record of actions taken pursuant to the inspection.
- 10. The report issued by the Department of Labor Wage & Hour Administration on July 28, 1992, finding that Gundersen failed to appeal original ruling within five days and that misstatements claimed by Gundersen were not related to original ruling.
- 11. All documents concerning an inspection or investigation performed by an NRC Office of Enforcement investigator at Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. (n/k/a NES, Inc.), 44 Shelter Rock Road, Danbury, Connecticut 06810, on or about August 1992, at the instigation of Complainant Gundersen,

including, but not limited to, complaints, letters, investigation notes, field notes, logs, affidavits, reports, conclusions, findings, and any record of actions taken pursuant to the inspection or investigation.

- 12. The September 25, 1992 report and recommendation from the Administrative Law Judge recommending dismissal of Gundersen's June 1992 complaint to Department of Labor Wage & Hour Administration.
- 13. The January 19, 1993 opinion of the Secretary of Labor adopting the Administrative Law Judge's report and recommendation and dismissing Gundersen's appeal.
- All documents concerning an inspection performed by an NRC Office of Investigations investigator at Nuclear Energy Services, Inc.(n/k/a NES, Inc.), 44 Shelter Rock Road, Danbury, Connecticut 06810, on or about June 1993, at the instigation of Complainant Gundersen, including, but not limited to, complaints, letters, investigation notes, field notes, logs, affidavits, reports, conclusions, findings, and any record of actions taken pursuant to the inspection or investigation.
- 15. The report issued by the NRC Office of Investigations on June 14, 1993 concluding that Gundersen was laid off as a result of a legitimate business decision.
- 16. All documents from the NRC Office of Inspector General referencing Gundersen and Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. n/k/a NES, Inc., including, but not limited to, Office of Inspector General Report No. 91-72A.
- 17. All documents from the NRC Office of Enforcement referencing Gundersen and Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. n/k/a NES, Inc.
- 18. All documents from the NRC Office of Inspector General referencing Gundersen and Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. n/k/a NES, Inc.
- 19. All documents from the Department of Labor Wage & Hour Administration, referencing Gundersen and Nuclear Energy Services, Inc. n/k/a NES, Inc.
