SUBJECT: Phonecon record for calls made on 8/15/90

Thonus gave me a phone number to track down the current status of the fuel canisters. He stated that most of the canisters were made by Joseph Oats Co. and not NES. He did say that some of the NES canisters did contain fuel debris and were stored in Idaho.

Klug stated that the TMI-2 fuel is stored in 343 fuel canisters in a pool in Test Area North at the Idaho National Engineering Lab (INEL). He also said that they were "pretty much done fuel samples." He told me to call Dick Schmidt, EG&G, at INEL, FTS 583-1837, for further details.

With Mike Tyacke, Project Engineer, EG&G, INEL FTS 583-1601

Acting for Schmidt. Tyacke confirmed that the 343 canisters were in the above pool. There were no current plans to take any more samples from the canisters. Any other fuel samples from TMI-2 were already stored elsewhere. He speculated that the current wet storage could continue for the next 30 years until the fuel is placed in a permanent repository. The fuel also may be place into dry storage within the next five years. He stated that money is not currently available for dry storage.
