IDR Schedule and Planning

Dear Mr. Geier:

We have reviewed the schedule for completion of the Independent Design Review (IDR) for the Clinton Power Station in light of the changes in scope made in the process of obtaining the recent approval of the Program Plan. Without altering the scope, technical content or level of detail of the approved Plan, we propose implementation as described below.

We are currently planning our effort, including any required manpower increases, so that we will be able to issue the Final Report approximately December 15, 1984. Although we would not issue a previous "draft" Report, we would plan to receive comments from Illinois Power Company (IP), the Huclear Regulatory Commission (RRC) and the public on the Final Report and to respond to such comments promptly. The response will include, if necessary, supplements and/or revisions to the Final Report. We think it is desirable that we be able to complete such response by January 15, 1985. Accordingly, we suggest that a public meeting be held on the Final Report approximately two weeks after it is issued, and that any written comments be submitted to us within a week after the public meeting.

In order that IP, the HRC and the public be able to review the Final Report promptly, we recommend an improved mechanism for making available information concerning the progress of the IDR. Instead of the single interim report contemplated by the Program Plan, we plan to provide three interim reports at approximately monthly intervals beginning October 1, 1984.

The outline of such monthly reports is attached. As you will note, each report will contain a narrative description of the status of each of the discrete tasks being performed and Appendices A and B will contain detailed information as to the results of the IDR effort to date, i.e., a surmary of all Potential Observation Reports and copies of each Observation Report and resolution thereof. The basic purpose of these interim reports will be to provide meaningful information, while the IDR is taking place, as to both the manner in which the IDR is being performed and the specific details of any deficiencies being identified by Bechtel. This should enable IP and the HRC to provide additional guidance, as appropriate, during the conduct of the IDR to assure the quality of the final product. It should also greatly facilitate the ability of IP, HRC and the public to review the Final Report within the period we suggest.

To assure that the objectives described above are met, we also propose that a public meeting be scheduled approximately 10 days after the issuance of each interim report.

We believe that the foregoing steps will improve the ability of IP. NRC and the public to contribute constructively to Pechtel's performance of the IDR. We would welcome your comments and suggestions.
