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The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 83 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-40 for the Fort Calhoun Station, Unit No. 1. This amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications and completes our response to your application dated October 3, 1983, as supplemented by letter dated June 22, 1984.

The amendment updates the surveillance capsule removal schedule (Table 3-7).

The amendment also corrects a typographical error that was made on TS page 2-98 which was issued on August 2, 1984 (Amendment 82). The containment wide range radiation monitors are RM-091 A and B and not RM-019 A and B.
