SUBJECT: INDEPENDENT DESIGN VERIFICATION PROGRAM - LIMERICK UNIT 1

Issuance of Torrey Pines Technology's Final report associated with the IDVP for Limerick Unit 1 is scheduled for October 12, 1984. The schedule does not provide the staff the opportunity to review the IDVP final report prior to your current fuel loading date. Philadelphia Electric Company is requested to provide, prior to the actual fuel loading, your assessment of the potential findings resulting from the IDVP work in progress and your judgement as to whether or not these findings, either individually or in the aggregate suggest basis for concern with regard to the effectiveness of the design process. Concurrent with submittal of your assessment of the potential findings, Torrey Pines Technology is requested to submit its independent assessment of the impact of its findings on the same concern. Both assessments should identify any finding that would potentially delay the startup program and full power operation. Absent any such adverse finding, completion of the IDVP should not prohibit granting the low power operating license for Limerick Unit 1.
