Gentlemen:

On July 9, 1975, Applicant's Counsel requested the Board to receive additional evidence in the form of affidavits to supplement the Initial Decision. (DCI-75/18, 902) relating to the Applicant's financial qualifications to design and construct WPP-4. Alternatively, Applicant's Counsel suggested that if a hearing is required on this one remaining matter it should be held in the Washington, D.C. area. We join in the Applicant's request that the record be supplemented by affidavits, followed by submission of proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law by the parties, and by a final Board decision authorizing the issuance of a construction permit for WPP-4.

By way of background, on October 8, 1975, Applicant informed the NRC Staff of a delay in the signing of participation agreements (contracts to purchase a certain percentage of the capability of the facility) with the participants for WPP-4. (Applicant's Exhibit 17). The signed agreements are necessary to the finding of reasonable assurance that Applicant is financially qualified, pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR 50.35(f), to design and construct WPP-4. The delay in signing agreements for WPP-4 resulted from the decision to complete the environmental analysis required by State law (Washington State Environmental Policy Act ("SEPA"), R.C.M. 642.210) prior to execution of the participants agreements.
