SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-260/88-38

This letter forwards a report on the results of a special inspection of the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant (BFN) Seismic Design Program conducted at the TVA offices at the BFN site (Decatur, Alabama) between October 30 and November 10, 1988. A total of 32 items in the design areas of amplified response spectra generation, drywell platform, miscellaneous steel, electrical conduit and supports, and HVAC ductwork and supports were identified. As of the end of this inspection period, 28 items remain open. Some of the items were subsequently closed as a result of followup inspections by the staff; however, they are still listed as open items in this inspection report.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
