Subject: WPPSS NUCLEAR PROJECT NO. 1
AMENDMENT 1 TO THE FORMAL APPLICATION



Dear Mr. Giambusso:

In accordance with 10CFR Part 50, Washington Public Power Supply System ("WPPSS") herewith submits 48 copies of Amendment No. 1 to the WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 1 ("WNP-1") formal application (i.e., the 10CFR 50.33 and 50.37 information) for Class 103 licenses to construct and operate the WNP-1 facility. Instructions for incorporating the amendment into the Application are included with the amendment.

The purpose of Amendment No. 1 is to include proposed WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 4 ("WNP-4") in the application for concurrent AEC review with WNP-1. In this regard, the Executive Committee of WPPSS adopted a plan and system resolution on July 12, 1974, authorizing the submission of this amendment to address the construction of WNP-4 in conjunction with and at the same site as WNP-1, as relocated.

On July 15, 1974, we submitted Amendment No. 1 to the Environmental Report ("ER") which revised the ER to provide revised information occasioned by the relocation of WNP-1 and the addition of its "twin", WNP-4.

Likewise, the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report ("PSAR") was amended on May 31, 1974 (Amendment No. 7) and July 1, 1974 (Amendment No. 8) to address the relocation of WNP-1 and the construction of WNP-4 in conjunction with WNP-1. The remaining amendment of the PSAR relative to relocation and the additional unit will be filed on or about August 8, 1974.

As described in the PSAR, the only systems which will be shared between WNP-1 and WNP-4 are the off-site electrical system, the cooling tower make-up and blowdown systems and the meteorological monitoring system (also to be shared with WNP-2 (formerly Hanford 2)).


