SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-445/92-12; 50-446/92-12

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. D. N. Graves, R. M. Latta, C. E. Johnson, V. G. Gaddy, A. Singh, D. L. Kelley, and M. E. Murphy during the period March 22 through May 2, 1992, of activities authorized for the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection included plant status, followup on corrective actions for violations, followup on licensee actions on construction deficiencies, followup on NRC Bulletins, routine plant tours, preoperational test program implementation verification, preoperational test procedure review, preoperational test witnessing, and fuel receipt and storage.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified. However, the incident described in the enclosed inspection report regarding the battery exhaust fan work activity is of particular concern because of the potential for personnel injury.

Strengths noted during this inspection period included the high quality of the packages provided by your licensing organization for closure of regulatory items such as significant deficiency analysis reports, violations, and NRC Bulletins. The documentation provided with these closure packages was thorough and provided an efficient mechanism for the review of your corrective actions. Additionally, the preoperational test procedures that were reviewed were well written. The additional resources you have allocated to that activity have resulted in procedures that were improved, although the time


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between test procedure approval and the initiation of testing activities allowed limited time for NRC review of the approved procedure.
