Please find attached a proposed amendment to the Catawba Nuclear Station Technical Specifications. This proposed revision allows the use of the B&W Kinetic Sleeving process, as described in BAW-2045P, Rev. 1 (Recirculating steam generator Kinetic Sleeve Qualification For 3/4 inch OD Tubes), to repair steam generator tubes. This Topical Report was submitted by B&W Nuclear Service Company on March 31, 1992. Duke Power is requesting timely review and approval of BAW-2045P, Rev. 1, and this submittal so that this repair technique will be available in the event that a large number of tubes need to be repaired during the refuelling outage for Catawba Unit 1, which is scheduled to begin on July 10, 1992. Catawba is currently scheduled to begin S/G repairs on July 23, 1992.

Attachment I contains the Technical Specification Mark-ups, Attachment II contains the Technical Justification and Attachment III contains the No Significant Hazards Analysis.
