

Dear Mr. Thomas:

The process of issuing an order authorizing "Disposition of Component Parts and Termination of Facility License" is taking an extended period of time. We need to prepare the space in the Nuclear Facility, where our AGN-201 reactor is located, to house a wind tunnel. We therefore request permission from the USNRC to move the AGN-201 reactor vessel outside the Engineering Building (yet still well within the confines of the property of Tuskegee Institute) and to remove a stacked concrete wall presently dividing off the "reactor area" from the rest of the Nuclear Facility.
