Subject: Inspection No. 50-352/84-41

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. Nemen M. Terc of this office and other members of an NRC team on July 24-27, 1984 at the Limerick Generating Station of activities authorized by NRC License No. CCPR-106 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. N. M. Terc with Mr. V. S. Boyer and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to observation of your emergency exercise conducted on July 25, 1984. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. Within the scope and limitations of the exercise scenario, the emergency response actions of your staff demonstrated the capability to adequately implement your emergency plans and procedures to provide protective measures for the health and safety of the public.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were observed.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1). The telephone notification of your intent to request withholding or any request for an extension of the 10 day period which you believe necessary, should be made to the Supervisor, Files, Mail and Records, U.S. NRC Region I, at (215) 337-5223.

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No reply to this letter is required. Your cooperation with us in this matter is appreciated.
