Dr. Uhrig. Dr. Uhrig previously testified in an NRC proceeding in 1973 concerning the Florida Power & Light Company facility, St. Lucie, Unit 1. Dr. Uhrig believes it was the remanded construction permit proceeding on environmental matters.
