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TRT ACTIVITIES AT COMANCHE PEAK SESSION IV - SEPTEMBER 9-21, 1984

General

- Approximately 50 r ople on team (some part time).
- Approximately 500 allegations being worked on. (Many are general and vague. This is an increase of about 100 allegations from the "plan").
- Investigation of electrical, civil/structural, mechanical/piping, and test program allegations is essentially complete; draft SSERs in final stages of revision.
- Meeting with TUGCO held September 18, 1984, in Bethesda to present results of TRT review in electrical, civil, and test program areas.
- Tentative date for second meeting with TUGCO to present TRT results in mechanical, coatings, QA/QC, and miscellaneous areas is October 18, 1984.
- QA/QC area requires a fifth session. Complexity of issues and turnover of contractor personnel has impacted activity and completion of reviews.
- Region IV completed 219 line items and 60 inspection procedures as of September 21, 1984.

Efforts to locate allegers include requests to OI and Region IV, confidential examination of applicant personnel files, inquiries to the phone company and post office, and selected inquiries to relatives. co-workers, CASE and GAP.

Potential Problems

- Completion of QA/QC reviews and in-field as-built verification program.
- Maintaining continuity of TRT staff beyond the close of the fifth session will be difficult.
- A special effort is being made to obtain potential allegations being withheld by one individual and by GAP. Most of the individual's allegations (280 vice 1,000, as previously expected) have been obtained and a review program is being developed. No additional allegations have been provided by GAP.

Non-TRT Matters

- Tentative initiation of Fire Protection Team Inspection is scheduled for October 29, 1984. Attempts are being made to accelerate that date.
- Intimidation/Harrassment Hearings are scheduled to resume October 1-3, 1984.
- The final major Region IV building/room turnover inspection effort (Safeguards and Auxiliary Buildings) will be completed the week of September 24.
- Applicant schedule for fuel load remains at mid-October 1984.

Fifth Session

- QA/QC group onsite for 2 weeks; portions of coatings and mechanical groups onsite part-time.
- Continue review/resolution of all allegations.
- Continue to integrate into draft SSER. Ten to fifteen contactor personnel in Bethesda to continue documentation effort.
