This acknowledges the receipt of your July 25, 1984, letter by which you transmitted for licensing action changes to the Wolf Creek Generating Station Physical Security Plan, for the protection of special nuclear material for low strategic significance, prior to obtaining an operating license (Interim Security Plan) for your facility.

We find the changes, as described in the subject letter and its attachment, to be consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(e). Accordingly, it is acceptable for inclusion into the plan. The use of the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p) would not yet be appropriate under your materials license SNM-1929 since the current activities are being conducted under NRC construction permit CPPR-147.

The enclosure to your letter dated July 25, 1984, is being withheld from public disclosure because it contains safeguards information and must be protected in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 73.21.
