Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter of August 22, 1984, in response to our letter and the attached Notice of Violation dated July 23, 1984. As a result of our review, we find additional information, as discussed with your Mr. Jim Fisicaro during a telephone call on September 5, 1984, is needed. Specifically, please indicate actions you have taken to determine that no additional CQE material entered the plant without benefit of a stores or quality assurance inspection; actions you have taken to strengthen the requisition procedures such that no material can enter the plant without a stores inspection and, as required, a quality assurance inspection; and changes you have implemented in the purchase order requisition system to incorporate the quality control factor on future requisitions.

Please provide the supplemental information within 10 days of your receipt of this letter so that we can continue our review of this matter.
