Dear Mr. Chilk:

This will confirm my conversation with your office on September 28, regarding the Petitions for Review of ALAB-781 and ALAB-782 filed by the Joint Intervenors in this proceeding on September 17, 1984. Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.786(b)(3), answers to these petitions would be required to be filed on October 2, 1984.

Because of the late receipt of the Petitions for Review (on September 24, 1984) and the need to prepare another pleading in this poroceeding in the same timeframe, the Staff determined that an extension of the reply date would be necessary. Accordingly, we contacted counsel for Pacific Gas and Electric Company and counsel for the Joint Intervenors regarding an extension of time until October 12, 1984 for the filing of the Staff's answers to these Petitions; they have no objection. On this basis, we then requested and you granted leave to the Staff to file answers to the Petitions by October 12, 1984.
