## SUBJECT: ACTIONS IN RESPONSE TO TROPICAL STORM ISIDOR

Today's 3 p.m. (EDT) National Weather Service advisory reported the center of Tropical Storm Isidore near latitude 24.8 north and longitude 78.0 west, about 160 miles east southeast of Miami. The storm is expected to resume a westerly track tonight and Thursday. Currently, the storm is stationary, increasing the potential for strengthening. The highest sustained winds are 45 miles per hour with gales outward up to 100 miles. Florida Power and Light is monitoring the storm and will activate their severe weather procedures if the tropical storm is upgraded to a hurricane.

Region II will continue to monitor the storm.
Media interest is expected. Neither the NRC nor the licensee plans to issue a news release, but both are prepared to respond to media inquiries.
