ORDER

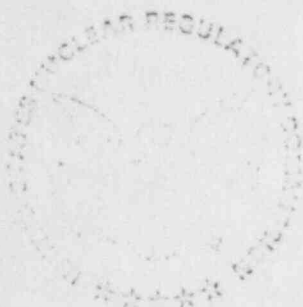
On August 20, 1984 Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) requested a three-year extension of the termination date of September 22, 1984 in the Facility Operating License DPR-76 (license) which authorizes PG&E to operate the Diablo Canyon Power Plant, Unit No. 1 (Diablo Canyon) at low power. In response to this request, Joint Intervenors requested a hearing pursuant to Section 189a of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, for the reasons previously presented in Joint Intervenors' earlier requests for hearings on PG&E's previous requests for extensions of the termination date in the Diablo Canyon license. The Commission finds that its previous decisions denying Joint Intervenors prior requests for hearings on prior extension requests are equally applicable to Joint Intervenors' current request. See, CLI-83-27 and CLI-84-5. Accordingly, Joint Intervenors' request for a hearing is denied, and staff is
