2. I received a Bachelors Degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Illinois and a Masters Degree in Mechanical Engineering from Old Dominion University.

3. Upon graduation from the University of Illinois, I worked as a design engineer for Newport News Shipbuilding and Drydock Company in Newport News, Virginia for four years. This work was primarily in the areas of heat transfer and fluid-flow analysis and radiation-shielding design associated with Naval Nuclear propulsion power plants.
