

Schedule For Submittal of the
Fire Hazards Analysis Report

Previously, Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) verbally notified the NRC Licensing Project Manager (LPM) of a delay in the submittal of the Fire Hazards Analysis Report (FHAR). HL&P has reevaluated and revised the STP fire protection criteria to be used in performing the analysis and will submit the revised FHAR by February 1, 1985. HL&P would like to meet with the NRC staff on, or about, September 27, 1984 to discuss the revised approach that we are implementing on the South Texas Project (STP).
