Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. W. Snell and J. Patterson of this office on July 23-27, 1984, of activities at Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-24 and No. DPR-27, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. R. Link and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in non-compliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix A. A written response is required.

Weaknesses that were identified in this inspection are summarized in the attached Appendix B to this letter. Please advise us within 45 days of the date of this letter of the actions you plan to take showing the estimated date of completion, with regard to these weaknesses.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1). If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified periods noted above, a copy of this letter, the enclosures, and your response to this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.

The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

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We will gladly discuss any questions you have concerning this inspection.
