SUBJECT: DOCKET NOS. 50-338 AND 50-339, NORTH ANNA POWER STATION RADIOLOGICAL
EMERGENCY PLAN REVIEW

We have completed the review of Revisions 6, 7, and 8 of the North Anna
Radiological Emergency Plan dated November 21, 1983, December 14, 1983, and
September 27, 1984, respectively.

Our review indicates that one of the changes is inconsistent with the provisions
of 10 CFR 50.54(q), 10 CFR 50.47(b), 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, and Sections 8.3 and
8.4 of NUREG-0737, Supplement 1.

The inconsistency appears on pg. 1.7 of the Plan under the Title, Emergency
Operations Facility, where a reference was deleted that states that
communications would be established between the OSC and the EOF. Failure to
provide for this is inconsistent with the requirements of paragraphs 8.3 and 8.4
of NUREG-0737, Supplement 1, which states in part, that reliable voice
communications shall exist between the OSC and the EOF.

To preclude a violation of regulatory requirements, you must not continue to
implement the changes deemed inconsistent. Please modify your Plan to correct
those pages necessary to maintain Plan continuity. We request that these
corrections be provided to us within 45 days of the date of this letter.

Our review of the remainder of Revision 8 of the North Anna Radiological
Emergency Plan indicates that with the above exceptions, the provided changes
continue to meet the provisions of 10 CFR 50.47(b), 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, and
the specific criteria in Section II of NUREG-0654.
