Gentlemen:

On November 3, 1978, we submitted to you a check in the amount of \$30,816.00 as payment for NRC Invoice No. 011-79, which provided Arkansas Nuclear One-Unit 1 with primary financial protection for the period from November 8, 1978 through November 7, 1979. At that time, we required indemnification in the amount of \$140 million and were charged a fee of \$12 per year per Mwt capacity as stated in 10 CFR 140.7. We now understand that due to an increase in the number of reactors which would be charged a deferred premium under the Price-Anderson Act that, as of January 1, 1979, we require indemnification of less than \$99 million for which the fee is \$6 per year per Mwt capacity.

Based on the above, Arkansas Power and Light Company hereby requests a refund of \$13,128.00 to offset this change in fee.
