
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Gentlemen

Mr. Myron Goede, Radiation Physicist, has indicated that our teletherapy unit may be brought into compliance with the provisions of Section 20. 105 (a) of 10 CFR part 20, by applying option 2, stated in your letter, dated July 23, 1979.

Accordingly, a record shall be kept daily, in the daily log, indicating those instances in which the beamstopper was not interposed in the path of the primary beam. It is anticipated that the average radiation level outside of the room will be 0, since the beam will be pointed at the primary wall only if the beamstopper is not interposed to intercept the primary beam. The occupancy times are likely to be less than one fourth hour per hour and 10 hours per week.
