SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. R-12-92 CONCERNING THE BRUNSWICK STEAM  
ELECTRIC PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

Thank you for your letter dated July 6, 1992. Your letter enclosing a copy of Resolution No. R-12-92, which the Board of Commissioners of the North Carolina Eastern Municipal Power Agency adopted on June 24, 1992, regarding the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Units 1 and 2 (Brunswick) has been referred to me for response. The Resolution raises concerns about the performance at Brunswick. On July 2, 1992, the NRC placed the Brunswick plant on the "watch list" as a plant requiring increased NRC attention because of similar concerns. The NRC is taking action to ensure that Carolina Power & Light Company, the Brunswick plant licensee, acts to correct the problems at the facility.
