SUBJECT: Further County Action re Bethesda Nuclear Reactor

On June 16, we sent you a copy of the joint County Executive/Council President letter to Chairman Palladino of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and Director Griffith of the Defense Nuclear Agency in which Montgomery County urged them to consider four issues of County concern and not make summary disposition on any subject relating to them. These points had to do with licence renewal, monitoring results, oversight committee, and the emergency plan. To date, we have not received an answer from either of these agencies.

For your information, the Council Transportation and Environment Committee will be meeting at 2:30 p.m., on Tuesday, July 12, in the fifth floor conference room of the County Office Building to discuss what further action the County should take in this matter.
